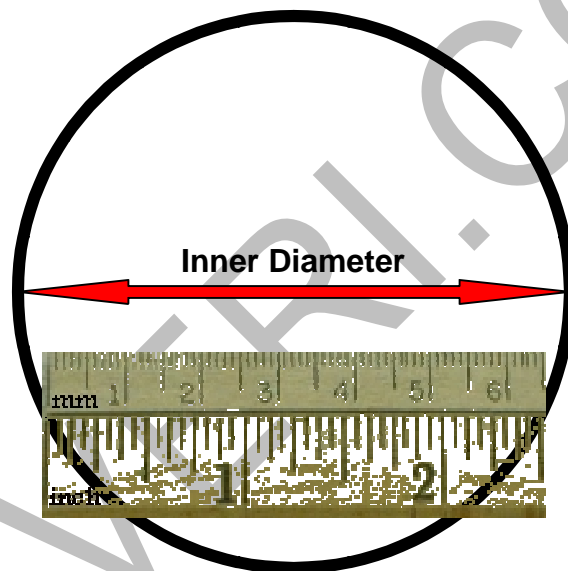


**There are two ways to know your bangle size:**

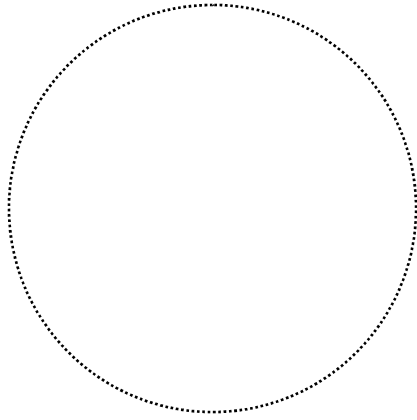
**1. Measure your existing bangle**

Take a ruler and place it along the centre of your bangle as shown in the picture. Read the measurement starting 0 inches on the scale from one inner end of the bangle to the other inner end. Please note that an inch is divided into 16 mm or 16 parts and a bangle size is stated in mm per inch. Therefore, a reading of 2.5 inches would mean that your bangle size is 2.8 i.e.  $8/16$ . Similarly, 2.25 inches would mean that your bangle size is 2.4 and so forth. Please note that the broader the bangle, the slight bigger the size you should consider and vice versa. Now that you have found your bangle size just select the correct size from our drop-down menu and proceed to checkout!

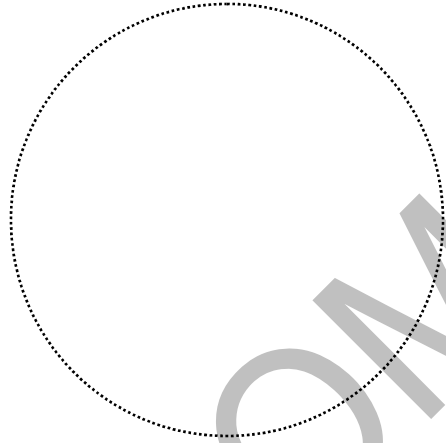


**2. Print our bangle size template**

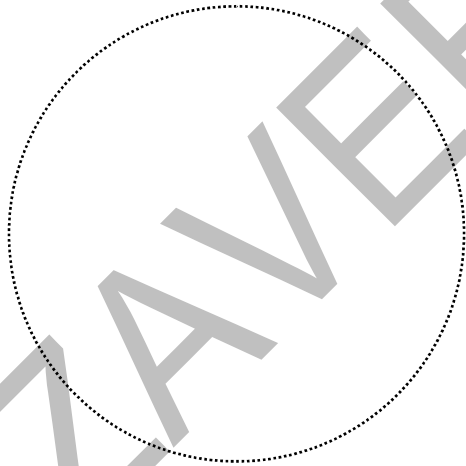
If you do not have any kind of bangle to measure, simply take a print out of our bangle-size template on the next page and measure from our available bangle-size outlines. All you need to do is cut out the circle that you think might be your size and simply slide in your hand through it. Below are four most common sizes. For accurate measurement or in-between sizes please try more than one circle. For example, if you think that circle 2.2 is slight tight for you whereas circle 2.4 is slight loose for you then your précised size will be 2.3". Again, please note that for broader bangles you should count one size bigger than your actual size and vice versa. Now that you have found your bangle size just select the correct size from our drop-down menu and proceed to checkout!



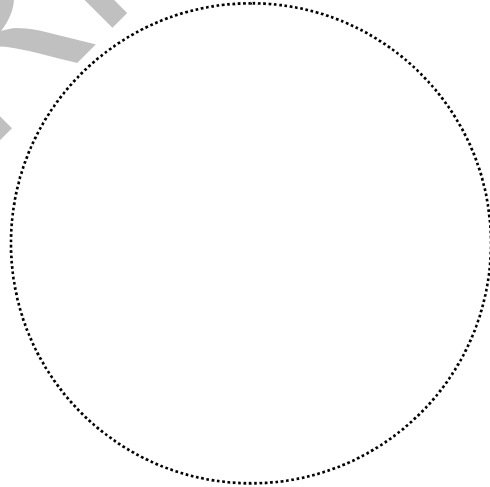
